

CENTRAL LAKE VILLAGE COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The regular meeting of the Village Council of March 10, 2008 was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Eckhardt. All members were present.

Motion made by Thomas and supported by Batterbee-Arnold to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion made by Patton and supported by Clark to approve the minutes of the February 11, 2008 meeting as printed in the Antrim Review with one correction. The correct amount for the accounts payable to be approved should have been \$46,533.84. Motion carried.

Police Report: Scott Barrett was introduced as our new police chief. He reported that there were 43 complaints handled by the Village Police Dept. during the month of February, 2008.

D.P.W. Report: Mullens reported on the DPW operations for the month of February, 2008. He reported on the shortage of salt for the roads in the area and what was being done because of that. He also reported on a frozen water line.

Committee Reports:

Streets and Sidewalks: Nothing to report.

Lights and Water: Possible changes to the water and sewer billings were discussed.

Law Enforcement: Nothing to report other than the hiring of the new police chief, Scott Barrett.

Finance and Personnel: Nothing to report.

Parks and Public Property: No bids were received by the Village for the Spring Clean Up. It was decided to send out letters to businesses that may be interested in this project to get prices.

President's Report:

- C. There was a lengthy discussion regarding the Personnel Policy handbook, including calling it the Employee Manual now. Updates and changes were discussed.
