- Are there no more than four (4) hens will be kept or confined on the parcel? Note: No roosters are all owned to be kept or confined within the Village.
- Is the parcel on which the hens will be kept or confined the principal residence of the owner of that parcel?
- Is the parcel on which the hens will kept or confined a single family dwelling?
- Are the hens kept or confined in a totally enclosed structure located in the rear yard of the parcel, with an optional covered fenced enclosed?
- Will the structure be constructed and maintained to prevent the structure becoming a breeding ground, food source or habitation place for rats, mice, or other rodents?
- Will the feed and other items associated with the hens be kept in a totally enclosed structure which shall be constructed and maintained to prevent becoming a breeding ground, food source or habitation place for rats, mice, or other rodents?
- Will the following be located on the parcel no less than 25 feet from any dwelling or neighboring parcel and 10 feet from the rear and side property lines: the structure in which the hens will be kept or confined, any optional covered fence enclosure, and any structure in which the feed and other items associated with the hens?
- Does the applicant agree that no hens will be slaughtered on the parcel outdoors?

- **Note:** If a license is granted as a result of this application it will be valid for one (1) year only. The permit can be renewed annually upon inspection of the property by a village official to assure continued compliance with the ordinance. A permit renewal fee will also be required.
- **Violations:** Any person who violates any provision of this Chapter shall be responsible for a municipal infraction as defined in Public Act 12 of 1994, amending Public Act 236 of 1961, being Sections 600.101-600.9939 of Michigan Compiled Laws, and shall be subject to a fine of Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$500.00) Dollars. Each day this Chapter is violated shall be considered a separate violation.
- **Enforcement Officials:** The police officers of the Village of Central Lake are hereby designated as the authorized officials to issue municipal civil infractions directing alleged violators of this Ordinance to appear in court.
- **Civil Action:** In addition to enforcing this Ordinance through the use of municipal civil infractions proceeding, the Village may initiate proceedings in the Circuit Court to abate or eliminate the nuisance per se or any other violation of this Ordinance.

If the requirements of Chapter 25 are not complied with, the Village may revoke any permit granted and/or initiate prosecuting for a civil infraction violation. A person who has been issued a permit shall submit it for examination upon demand by any police officer or code enforcement officer.

I understand the above restrictions on the permit and am submitting this application in compliance with Chapter 25 (Chickens) of the Central Lake Village Code.
