RESERVATIONS

The park opens the last Saturday in April and closes the third Saturday in October.

Call (231) 544-6483 or (231) 350-6394 or visit Thurstonpark.com for reservations.

- You must be at least 18 years old to rent a campsite.
- All campers must check in with the Campground Manager.
- Please fill out emergency contact card if you are planning on leaving your campsite unattended for any period of time.

RATES

- Waterfront sites: \$25 per day. Water and electric hookups are available.
- Non-Waterfront sites: \$20 per day. Water and electric hookups are available.
- Non-Waterfront site with water, electric and sewer hookups: \$25 per day.
- There is a \$6.00 reservation fee for every reservation made.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- 1 to 10 days: Full payment is expected at the time of reservation.
- 11 to 29 days: \$150.00 deposit is required at the time of reservation with the remainder due upon arrival. (must contact the Campground Manager or the village office for payment arrangements)
- Extended Stay 30+ days: \$150.00 deposit is required at the time of reservation with the remainder of the first month due at check in, then on a monthly basis from that point on, due on the first of the month. 30+ day reservations will receive a \$2.00 discount per night. (must contact the Campground Manager or the village office for payment arrangements)
- **Lake Front sites require a four night minimum stay, Memorial Day to Labor Day, on the weekends. Lake Front sites also have a 14 night maximum stay.**
- **All other sites are to be paid for at the time of occupancy at the full nightly rate and with no discount, if the reservation was not made online.**
- Reservations are accepted if the site is available.

CAMPSITE REMINDERS

- Site 8 is a tent site or popup trailer only site
- Sites 29-40 are full hookup sites, **NO TENTS ALLOWED**, unless permitted by the Campground Manager.

Check out time is **2 p.m.** Anyone on a lot after check out will be charged an additional day.

Cancellations made 72 hours prior to check in will receive a refund, less the \$6.00 reservation fee.

Cancellations made after that time will receive no refund.

Original campground reservation may be amended or modified, as requested, twice by the camper before the Village exercises its right to cancel the reservation. This is in an effort to ensure the availability of the site for other campers.

Reservations will be held for 24 hours unless notified by camper of later arrival. If there isn't notification the site will be held for 24 hours and rented out after 24 hours to another camper and no refund will be given.

CAMPSITE RULES

- Site must be tidy so lawn mowing can be done.
- Any unit sleeping more than 6 persons will be charged an addition \$6 per person/per day.
- Renters parking any equipment must be contained on ONE campsite.
- Boat trailers must be parked in designated areas only – your lot or on top of the hill.
- Five (5) mph speed limit throughout the park/campground.
- Campfires in designated areas only.
- All litter must be placed in plastic bags (provided by Campground Manager), tied and placed in the dumpster.
- Feeding of waterfowl is prohibited.
- Absolutely NO campers are allowed in the water within ten (10) feet of the boat launch and/or dock.
- There is NO lifeguard. Swim at your own risk.
- Mooring boats and other recreational equipment at locations other than specific boat slips are strictly at the risk and responsibility of the owner.

COURTEOUS CAMPING

We hope all of our campers enjoy their stay at Thurston Park. To ensure that this happens please be courteous to other campers.

- No loud music, profanity, use of weapons or air guns, or fireworks.
- Moderate drinking of alcohol is permitted at campsites only.
- Public intoxication will not be tolerated and will be reported to the police.
- Campers are responsible for securing all alcoholic beverages when not at their campsite. At no time shall coolers containing alcoholic beverages be left unattended or unsecured.
- Quiet hours are to be observed and will be enforced from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.

PETS

- Limit of TWO pets per unit.
- Pets must be leashed at all times and are NOT allowed in restroom.
- Length of leash shall not exceed six (6) feet.
- PET OWNER MUST CLEAN UP AFTER PET.

FISH CLEANING

- Thurston Park provides a Fish Cleaning House. Fish must be cleaned and scaled on paper. Soiled paper and fish cleanings must be placed in plastic bags, tied and deposited in the barrel in the Fish Cleaning House. Please keep this area clean.

The Campground Manager, in conjunction with local law enforcement, has the authority to evict campers who violate the above rules, local ordinances and/or State laws. Campers who are evicted from the Park shall receive NO refunds and shall NOT be allowed to return to the Park for the remainder of the season.
